

Learning Games: I Spy!

I spy is a guessing game where one player (the spy or it) chooses an object within sight and announces to the other players that "I spy with my little eye, something beginning with...", naming the first letter of the object. You can also use physical descriptions of items, such as, "something red" or "something smaller than an apple". Other players attempt to guess this object. If required and your child does not have language skills, you can infuse Occupational Therapy skills into this activity for students who need to develop a point. Other skills that can be infused include eye gaze for students who are working on looking at the item in the room, or even ambulation, for students to go and get the item in the room.
